Am I needed before or after lunch at this post? _____

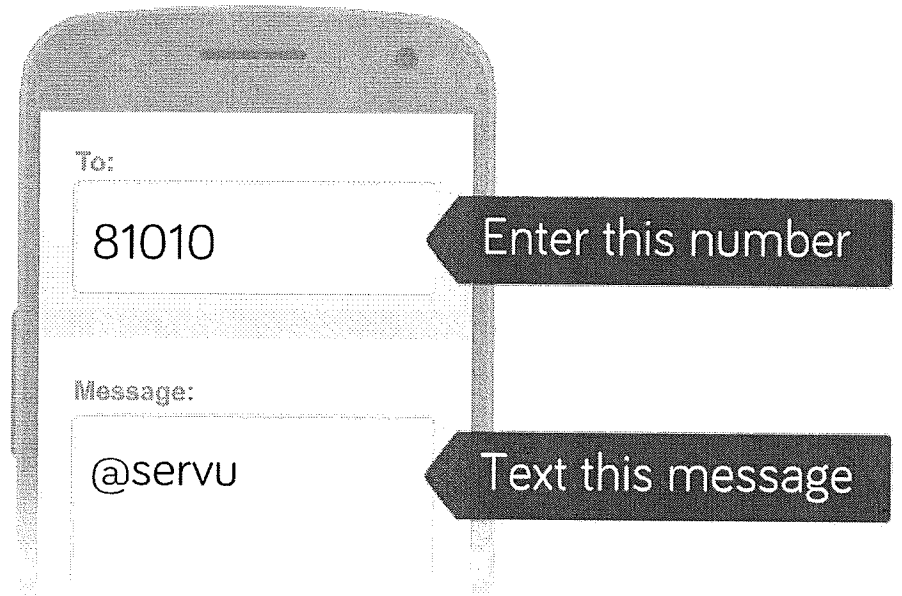
What are my duties on post?

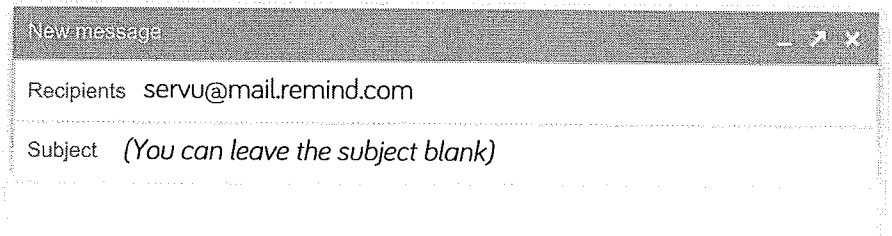
